A BILL

To prohibit entities from using Federal funds to contribute to political campaigns or participate in lobbying activities.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Taxpayer Money
- 5 for Corporate Campaigns Act of 2010".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR 2 CAMPAIGN AND LOBBYING ACTIVITIES. 3 With respect to Federal funds received by an entity, 4 other than a natural person, it shall be unlawful for such entity to— 5 (1) use such funds to advocate the election or 6 7 defeat of a political candidate; 8 (2) use such funds to engage in any lobbying 9 activity; or 10 (3) donate such funds to any entity that advo-
