- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Disabled Veteran
- 5 Small Business Eligibility Expansion Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF SERVICE-DISABLED VETERANS
- 7 UNDER 8(a) PROGRAM.
- 8 Section 8(a) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
- 9 637(a)) is amended—

2	"small business concern owned and controlled by so-

4	the following: ", or a small business concern owned
5	and controlled by service-disabled veterans,"; and
