 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Southeast Hurricanes
 - 5 Small Business Disaster Relief Act of 2010".
 - 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act—

1	(1) the terms "Administration" and "Adminis-
2	trator" mean the Small Business Administration
3	and the Administrator thereof, respectively;
4	(2) the term "covered disaster loan" means a
5	loan—
6	(A) made under section 7(b) of the Small
7	Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(b));
8	(B) for damage or injury caused by Hurri-
9	cane Katrina of 2005, Hurricane Rita of 2005,
10	Hurricane Gustav of 2008, or Hurricane Ike of
11	2008; and
12	(C) made to a business located in a de-
13	clared disaster area;
14	(3) the term "declared disaster area" means an
15	area in the State of Louisiana, State of Mississippi,
16	or State of Texas for which the President declared
17	a major disaster under section 401 of the Robert T.
18	Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance
19	Act (42 U.S.C. 5170) relating to Hurricane Katrina
20	of 2005, Hurricane Rita of 2005, Hurricane Gustav
21	of 2008, or Hurricane Ike of 2008;
22	(4) the term "program" means the Southeast
23	Hurricanes Small Business Disaster Relief Program
24	established under section 3; and

1	(5) the term "small business concern" has the
2	meaning given that term under section 3(a) of the
3	Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a)).
4	SEC. 3. SOUTHEAST HURRICANES SMALL BUSINESS DIS-
5	ASTER RELIEF PROGRAM.
6	(a) Program Established.—Subject to the avail-
7	ability of appropriations, the Administrator shall establish
8	a Southeast Hurricanes Small Business Disaster Relief
9	Program, under which the Administrator may waive pay-
10	ment of interest by a business on a covered disaster loan—
11	(1) for not more than 3 years; and
12	(2) in a total amount of not more than
13	\$15,000.
14	(b) Priority of Applications.—The Adminis-
15	trator shall, to the extent practicable, give priority to an
16	application for a waiver of interest under the program by
17	a small business concern—
18	(1) with not more than 50 employees; or
19	(2) that resumed business operations in a de-
20	clared disaster area during the period—
21	(A) beginning on September 1, 2005, and
22	ending on October 1, 2006, for loans relating to
23	Hurricane Katrina of 2005 or Hurricane Rita
24	of 2005: or

1	(B) beginning on September 1, 2008, and
2	ending on January 1, 2009, for loans relating
3	to Hurricane Gustav of 2008 or Hurricane Ike
4	of 2008.
5	(c) TERMINATION OF PROGRAM.—The Administrator
6	may not approve an application under the program after
