  PRODUCTS.

  (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 5114 of
- 8 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking
- 9 "of \$1 less than" and inserting "equal to".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall apply to claims filed on or after the

3 date of the enactment of this Act.
