5	Section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, is
6	amended by adding at the end the following new para-
7	graph:
8	"(37) a statement that sets forth the debt of
9	each bank, Government-sponsored enterprise (GSE),
10	and publicly traded or privately held company in
11	which the Government holds common stock, pre-
12	ferred stock, or warrants to purchase common stock
13	(equity) equaling at least ten percent of the com-
14	pany's total outstanding common stock.".
