3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Corporal Dustin Lee
- 5 Memorial Act".

SEC. 2. ADOPTION OF MILITARY WORKING DOG BY FAMILY OF DECEASED OR SERIOUSLY WOUNDED MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO WAS THE DOG'S HANDLER.

5 Section 2583(c) of title 10, United States Code, is6 amended—

7 (1) by inserting "(1)" before "Military ani-8 mals"; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new10 paragraph:

11 "(2) For purposes of making a determination under subsection (a)(2), unusual or extraordinary circumstances 12 may include situations in which the handler of a military 13 working dog is killed in action, dies of wounds received 14 in action, or is so seriously wounded in action that the 15 16 member will (or most likely will) receive a medical dis-17 charge. If the Secretary of the military department concerned determines that an adoption is justified in such a 18 19 situation, the military working dog shall be made available 20 for adoption only by the immediate family of the mem-21 ber.".
