LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ES-4 TABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN 5 COLORADO. 6 This proviso of the last sentence of the first section 7 of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter 950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting "or Colo-8 9 rado" after "Wyoming".
