## A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to prohibit the conversion of leadership PAC funds to personal use.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Leadership PAC Limi-  
5       tation Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING CONVERSION OF LEADERSHIP PAC**  
7       **FUNDS TO PERSONAL USE.**

8       (a) PROHIBITION.—Section 313(b)(1) of the Federal  
9       Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 439a(b)(1)) is  
10      amended by inserting after “subsection (a)” the following:

1 “or funds of a leadership PAC (as defined in section  
2 304(i)(8)(B))”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to elections occur-  
5 ring on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
