A BILL

To require the submission by the President of recommendations and proposed legislation to modernize, consolidate, reprioritize, and where necessary, terminate Federal programs, agencies, and activities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Efficiency and
- 5 Performance Act of 2009".

1	SEC. 2. PRESIDENTIAL RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE MOD-
2	ERNIZATION, CONSOLIDATION, REPRIORITI-
3	ZATION AND TERMINATION OF FEDERAL
4	PROGRAMS, AGENCIES AND ACTIVITIES.
5	Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
6	of this Act, the President shall submit to the Congress
7	recommendations, accompanied by proposed legislation, on
8	which existing Federal programs and agencies should be
9	modernized, consolidated, reprioritized, and where nec-
10	essary, terminated in order to—
11	(1) reduce Federal expenditures;
12	(2) increase efficiency and effectiveness of gov-
13	ernment operations;
14	(3) eliminate overlap and duplication in Federal
15	programs and offices;
16	(4) terminate agencies, programs and activities
17	that no longer serve an important governmental pur-
18	pose; and
19	(5) identify reductions in amounts of discre-
20	tionary budget authority or direct spending that can
21	be dedicated to Federal deficit reduction.
