- 5 SHED PROJECT CLAIMS.
- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Chief
- 7 of the Natural Resources Conservation Service shall use
- 8 discretionary funds available to the Natural Resources

- 1 Conservation Service to provide funds for the settlement
- 2 of claims associated with the Houlka Creek Watershed

3 Project in Mississippi to close out this project.
