Mrs. Kirkpatrick of Arizona introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of a small parcel of land in the Coconino National Forest, Arizona.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CHAPEL OF THE HOLY CROSS LAND SALE,
- 4 COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST, ARIZONA.
- 5 (a) Conveyance Required.—Not later than one
- 6 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary
- 7 of Agriculture shall convey, by sale, to the Roman Catholic
- 8 Diocese of Phoenix, Arizona (in this section referred to
- 9 as the "Diocese"), all right, title, and interest of the
- 10 United States in and to a parcel of land in the Coconino

- 1 National Forest, Arizona, consisting of the approximately
- 2 11.07 acres and identified as lot 26 in section 30 of Town-
- 3 ship 17 North, Range 6 East, Gila and Salt River Base
- 4 and Meridian, as generally depicted on the map entitled
- 5 "Chapel of the Holy Cross Parcel, Sedona, Arizona" and
- 6 dated October 2009.
- 7 (b) Consideration.—As consideration for the con-
- 8 veyance of the parcel under subsection (a), the Diocese
- 9 shall pay to the Secretary an amount equal to the fair
- 10 market value of the parcel, as determined by the Secretary
- 11 through an appraisal performed in accordance with—
- 12 (1) the Uniform Appraisal Standards for Fed-
- eral Land Acquisitions; and
- 14 (2) the Uniform Standards of Professional Ap-
- praisal Practice (USPAP).
- 16 (c) Use of Sale Proceeds.—Moneys received by
- 17 the Secretary from the sale of land under subsection (a)
- 18 shall be deposited in the fund established by Public Law
- 19 90-171 (commonly known as the Sisk Act; 16 U.S.C.
- 20 484a) for use by the Secretary for the acquisition of land
- 21 or interests in land from willing sellers within the
- 22 Coconino National Forest. To the maximum extent prac-
- 23 ticable, the Secretary shall utilize such moneys for the au-
- 24 thorized purpose within three years of the deposit of the
- 25 moneys in the Sisk Act fund.

- 1 (d) MINOR ERRORS.—The Secretary and the Diocese
- 2 may make, by mutual agreement, minor boundary adjust-
- 3 ments in the parcel directed for sale under subsection (a).
- 4 If there is a conflict between any map, acreage estimate,
- 5 or a description of the land under this section, the map
- 6 shall control unless the Secretary and the Diocese mutu-

7 ally agree otherwise.
