AN ACT

To direct unused appropriations for Members' Representational Allowances to be deposited in the Treasury and used for deficit reduction or to reduce the Federal debt.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. REQUIRING AMOUNTS REMAINING IN MEM-
2	BERS' REPRESENTATIONAL ALLOWANCES TO
3	BE USED FOR DEFICIT REDUCTION OR TO RE-
4	DUCE THE FEDERAL DEBT.
5	(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6	sion of law, any amounts appropriated for Members' Rep-
7	resentational Allowances for the House of Representatives
8	for a fiscal year which remain after all payments are made
9	under such Allowances for the year shall be deposited in
10	the Treasury and used for deficit reduction, except that
11	in the case of a fiscal year for which there is no Federal
12	budget deficit, such amounts shall be used to reduce the
13	Federal debt (in such manner as the Secretary of the
14	Treasury considers appropriate).
15	(b) Effective Date.—This section shall apply with
16	respect to fiscal year 2011 and each succeeding fiscal year.
