INCREASE IN DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SHARE OF 2 EXPENSES FOR NEW PROGRAMS STATE 3 UNDER NATIONAL GUARD YOUTH CHAL-4 LENGE PROGRAM. 5 (a) INCREASED SHARE AUTHORIZED.—Section 509(d) of title 32, United States Code, is amended— 6 7 (1) by redesignating paragraph (2) as para-8 graph (3); and 9 (2) by inserting after paragraph (1) the fol-10 lowing new paragraph: 11 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), for the first three fiscal years during which a State program of the 12 Program is in operation, the amount of assistance pro-13 14 vided by the Secretary of Defense to the State program may not exceed 100 percent of the costs of operating the 15 State program.". 16
