A BILL

To prohibit the enforcement of a climate change interpretive guidance issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Maintaining Agency
5 Direction on Financial Fraud Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INTERPRETIVE GUIDANCE NULL AND VOID.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no inter-
8 pretive guidance issued by the Securities and Exchange

1 Commission on or after the effective date of this Act relat-
2 ing to “Commission Guidance Regarding Disclosure Re-
3 lated to Climate Change”, affecting Parts 211, 231, and
4 249 of title 17, Code of Federal Regulations, (as described
5 in Commission Release Nos. 33–9106; 34–61469; FR–
6 82), or any successor thereto, may take effect, and such
7 guidance shall have no force or effect with respect to any
8 person on or after February 2, 2010.
