3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (3) of section 529(e)
4 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by add5 ing at the end the following new subparagraph:

6 "(C) TEMPORARY RULE FOR STUDENT 7 LOANS.—For purposes of this paragraph, any 8 interest or principal paid after December 31, 9 2009, and before January 1, 2015, with respect 10 to a qualified education loan (as defined in sec-11 tion 221) with respect to a designated bene-12 ficiary shall be treated as a qualified higher 13 education expense.".

14 (b) Conforming Amendments.—

(1) Subparagraph (A) of section 72(t)(7) of
such Code is amended by inserting "determined
without regard to subparagraph (C) thereof" after
"section 529(e)(3)".

(2) Clause (i) of section 530(b)(2)(A) of such
Code is amended by inserting "determined without
regard to subparagraph (C) thereof" after "section
529(e)(3)".

23 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
24 this section shall apply to distributions made after Decem25 ber 31, 2009.
