A BILL

To prohibit the Internal Revenue Service from hiring new employees to enforce the Federal Government's invasion into the health care lives of American citizens.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Prevent IRS Overreach
- 5 Act of 2010".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IRS FROM HIRING NEW EMPLOY-
2	EES TO ENFORCE PATIENT PROTECTION AND
3	AFFORDABLE CARE ACT AND HEALTH CARE
4	AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT OF
5	2010.
6	No position within the Internal Revenue Service may
7	be filled, by transfer or any other appointment taking ef-
8	fect on or after the date of enactment of this Act, if the
9	duties and responsibilities of such position include the en-
10	forcement of any provision of, or amendment made by, the
11	Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act or the Health
12	Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010.
