- 7 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Notwithstanding the time lim-
- 8 itations specified in section 3744 of title 10, United States

- 1 Code, or any other time limitation with respect to the
- 2 awarding of certain medals to persons who served in the
- 3 Armed Forces, the President is authorized and requested
- 4 to award the Medal of Honor posthumously under section
- 5 3741 of such title to former Major Dominic S. Gentile of
- 6 the United States Army Air Forces for the acts of valor
- 7 during World War II described in subsection (b).
- 8 (b) Acts of Valor Described.—The acts of valor
- 9 referred to in subsection (a) are the actions of then Major
- 10 Dominic S. Gentile who, as a pilot of a P-51 Mustang
- 11 in the Army's 336th Fighter Squadron, Fourth Fighter
- 12 Group, of the Eighth Air Force in Europe during World
- 13 War II, destroyed at least 30 enemy aircraft.
