SECTION 1. REPEAL OF THE PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT AND THE HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT OF 2010.

5 (a) PPACA.—Effective as of the enactment of the 6 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, such Act is 7 repealed, and the provisions of law amended or repealed 8 by such Act are restored or revived as if such Act had 9 not been enacted.

10 (b) HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILI-11 ATION ACT OF 2010.—Effective as of the enactment of 12 the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 13 2010, such Act is repealed, and the provisions of law 14 amended or repealed by such Act are restored or revived 15 as if such Act had not been enacted.

16 SEC. 2. ENACTMENT OF THE OPTION ACT OF 2009.

17 The bill H.R. 3889 (111th Congress), as introduced18 in the House of Representatives on October 21, 2009, is19 hereby enacted into law.

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
