- 3 pany (as defined in section 167(h)(5)(B))".

- 6 PAYERS WITH OIL RELATED QUALIFIED PRODUCTION AC-
- 7 TIVITIES INCOME" and inserting "MAJOR INTEGRATED OIL
- 8 COMPANIES".
- 9 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 10 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
- 11 December 31, 2009.
