A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide penalties for transporting minors in foreign commerce for the purposes of female genital mutilation.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Girls Protection Act
- 5 of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. TRANSPORT FOR FEMALE GENITAL MUTILATION.
- 7 Section 116 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 9 "(d) Whoever, being a United States citizen or alien
- 10 admitted for permanent residence in the United States,

- 1 knowingly transports a person in foreign commerce for the
- 2 purpose of conduct with regard to that person that would
- 3 be a violation of subsection (a) if the conduct occurred
- 4 within the United States, or attempts to do so, shall be
- 5 fined under this title or imprisoned not more than 5 years,

6 or both.".
