To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide for the loss of United States citizenship by individuals who are unprivileged enemy belligerents.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Revoking Citizenship
- 5 for Terrorists Act of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. LOSS OF NATIONALITY BY UNPRIVILEGED ENEMY
- 7 BELLIGERENTS.
- 8 Section 349(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 9 Act (8 U.S.C. 1481(a)) is amended—

1	(1) in paragraphs (1) through (6), by striking
2	"or" at the end;
3	(2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period at
4	the end and inserting "; or"; and
5	(3) by adding at the end the following:
6	"(8) being an unprivileged enemy belligerent
7	(as such term is defined in section 948a(7) of title
8	10, United States Code).".
