3	(2) by striking "July 1, 2010" each place it ap-
4	pears and inserting "May 1, 2011".
5	(c) Special Rule for Individuals on Qualified
6	Official Extended Duty Outside the United
7	STATES.—Paragraph (3) of section 36(h) of such Code
8	is amended—
9	(1) by striking "May 1, 2010" in the matter
10	preceding subparagraph (A) and inserting "January
11	1, 2011",
12	(2) by striking "'May 1, 2011' for 'May 1,
13	2010'" and inserting "'January 1, 2012' for 'Janu-
14	ary 1, 2011'", and
15	(3) by striking "'July 1, 2011' for July 1,
16	2010'" and inserting "'May 1, 2012' for 'May 1,
17	2011'''.
18	(d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
19	this section shall apply to residences purchased after April
20	30, 2010.
