INCREASE OF MAXIMUM AGE FOR CHILDREN 4 **ELIGIBLE** FOR MEDICAL **CARE UNDER** 5 CHAMPVA PROGRAM. 6 (a) Increase.—Section 1781(c) of title 38, United 7 States Code, is amended— (1) by striking "twenty-three" and inserting 8

"twenty-six"; and
