### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "United States Postal
- 5 Service Postal Inspectors Equity Act".

### 6 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR AVAILABILITY PAY.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5545a of title 5, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol9 lowing:

"(1) The provisions of subsections (a)-(h) providing 1 2 for availability pay shall apply to a Postal Inspector. For the purpose of this section, section 5542(d) of this title, 3 4 and section 13(a)(16) and (b)(30) of the Fair Labor 5 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 213(a)(16) and 6 (b)(30), a Postal Inspector shall be deemed to be a crimi-7 nal investigator as defined in this section. For purposes of this subsection, the term 'Postal Inspector' has the 8 9 meaning given such term under section 1003(c) of title 39.". 10

(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 410(b)(11)
of title 39, United States Code, is amended by striking
"Section 5520a" and inserting "Sections 5520a and
4 5545a".
