1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE.

4 Section 24706 of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub6 section:

7 "(d) DISCONTINUANCE FOR REVENUE LOSS.—Am8 trak shall discontinue service on any long distance route
9 with respect to which total direct costs are more than

1 twice as great as total revenues for the first full fiscal year

2 beginning after the date of enactment of this subsection.".
