A BILL

To provide for a temporary freeze on the pay of civilian
employees of the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAY FREEZE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, for purposes of computing compensation for
6 service performed during fiscal year 2011 and the first
7 quarter of fiscal year 2012, the rate of salary or basic
8 pay for any office or position within the civil service, as
9 defined by section 2101 of title 5, United States Code,
10 shall be deemed to be equal to the rate of salary or basic

1 pay payable for such office or position as of September
2 30, 2010.

3 (b) RULE FOR NEW POSITIONS.—For purposes of
4 subsection (a), the rate of salary or basic pay payable as
5 of September 30, 2010, for any office or position which
6 was not in existence on such date shall be deemed to be
7 the rate of salary or basic pay payable to individuals in
8 comparable offices or positions on such date.

9 (c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
10 tion shall be considered to apply with respect to any office
11 or position within the uniformed services, as defined by
12 section 2101 of title 5, United States Code.
