- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FIVE-YEAR RECOVER PERIOD FOR COMPUTER-
- 4 BASED GAMBLING MACHINES.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
- 6 168(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amend-
- 7 ed by striking "and" at the end of clause (vi)(III), by
- 8 striking the period at the end of clause (vii) and inserting
- 9 ", and", and by adding at the end the following new
- 10 clause:

1	"(viii) any computer-based gambling
2	machine, including slot machines and video
3	lottery terminals.".
4	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
5	this section shall apply to property placed in service after
6	the date of the enactment of this Act.
