Mr. PERRIELLO introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To expand the boundary of Booker T. Washington National
Monument, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Booker T. Washington
5 Boundary Expansion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY MODIFICATION AND CORRECTIONS.**

7 The Act entitled “An Act to provide for the establish-
8 ment of the Booker T. Washington National Monument”,
9 approved April 2, 1956 (16 U.S.C. 4501l et seq.) is amend-
10 ed as follows:

1 (1) by striking section 4;

2 (2) by redesignating section 5 as section 4;

3 (3) by amending section 4(a), as redesignated
4 by subsection (b), to read as follows:

5 “(a) LANDS ADDED TO MONUMENT.—The boundary
6 of the Booker T. Washington National Monument is modi-
7 fied to include—

8 “(1) the approximately 15 acres, as generally
9 depicted on the map entitled ‘Boundary Map, Book-
10 er T. Washington National Monument, Franklin
11 County, Virginia’, numbered BOWA 404/80,024,
12 and dated February 2001; and

13 “(2) the approximately 67.5 acres, as generally
14 depicted on the map entitled ‘_____’,
15 numbered _____ and dated _____.”;

16 (4) by adding after section 4(c), as redesignated
17 by subsection (b), the following new subsection—

18 “(d) AVAILABILITY OF MAPS.—The maps referenced
19 in subsection (a) shall be on file and available for inspec-
20 tion in the appropriate offices of the National Park Serv-
21 ice, Department of the Interior.”; and

22 (5) by adding at the end the following new sec-
23 tion:

1 **“SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 “There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
3 as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this
4 Act.”.
