To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act with respect to adopted alien children.

2	This Act may be cited as the "International Adoption
3	Harmonization Act of 2010".

11 SEC. 4. COMPLIANCE WITH PAYGO.

12 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of 13 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to the latest statement 14 15 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 16 by the Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of the 17 House of Representatives, provided that such statement 18 has been submitted prior to the vote on passage. 19
