"(p) APPLICABILITY OF FOIA.—Notwithstanding 7 8 section 551 of title 5, United States Code, during any pe-9 riod that the corporation is under conservatorship or re-10 ceivership pursuant to section 1367 of the Federal Hous-11 ing Enterprises Financial Safety and Soundness Act of 1992 (12 U.S.C. 4617), the corporation shall be consid-12 13 ered to be an agency for purposes of section 552 of such title.". 14

(b) FREDDIE MAC.—Section 307 of the Federal
Home Loan Mortgage Corporation Act (12 U.S.C. 1456)
is amended by adding at the end the following new subsection:

"(h) APPLICABILITY OF FOIA.—Notwithstanding
section 551 of title 5, United States Code, during any period that the Corporation is under conservatorship or receivership pursuant to section 1367 of the Federal Housing Enterprises Financial Safety and Soundness Act of
1992 (12 U.S.C. 4617), the Corporation shall be consid-
