A BILL

To amend chapter 2 of title I of the United States Code to establish the style for amending laws.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Legislative Trans-5 parency Act of 2010".

6 SEC. 2. AMENDING LAWS.

7 Chapter 2 of title 1 of the United States Code is8 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

1 "§ 115. Amending laws

"No Act shall be revised or amended by mere ref-2 erence to it. Every bill or joint resolution which amends 3 4 an existing section, subsection, or other subdivision of any 5 Act shall set forth the section, subsection, or other subdivision sufficiently to enable the intent and effect of the bill 6 7 or joint resolution to be clearly understood. The matter to be deleted shall be enclosed in brackets and any new 8 9 matter added shall be in italics.".

10 SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENT.

11 The table of section at the beginning of chapter 2 12 of title 1 of the United States Code is amended by adding 13 after the item relating to section 114 the following new 14 item:

"115. Amending laws.".
