- 7 following: "(1) directly or indirectly solicits, contracts for,
- 8 charges, or receives, or attempts to solicit, contract for,

- 1 charge, or receive, any fee or compensation except as pro-
- 2 vided in sections 5904 or 1984 of this title, or (2)".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to actions taken
- 5 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
