Mr. KIRK introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

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## A BILL

To permit certain school districts in Illinois to be reconstituted for purposes of determining assistance under the Impact Aid program.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR IMPACT AID PAYMENT.**

4       (a) LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES.—Notwith-  
5       standing section 8013(9)(B) of the Elementary and Sec-  
6       ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7713(9)(B)),  
7       North Chicago Community Unit School District 187,  
8       North Shore District 112, and Township High School Dis-  
9       trict 113 in Lake County, Illinois, and Glenview Public  
10      School District 34 and Glenbrook High School District

1 225 in Cook County, Illinois, shall be considered local edu-  
2 cational agencies as such term is used in and for purposes  
3 of title VIII of such Act.

4 (b) COMPUTATION.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
5 vision of law, federally connected children (as determined  
6 under section 8003(a) of the Elementary and Secondary  
7 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7703(a))) who are in  
8 attendance in the North Shore District 112, Township  
9 High School District 113, Glenview Public School District  
10 34, and Glenbrook High School District 225 described in  
11 subsection (a), shall be considered to be in attendance in  
12 the North Chicago Community Unit School District 187  
13 described in subsection (a), solely for purposes of com-  
14 puting the amount that the North Chicago Community  
15 Unit School District 187 is eligible to receive under sub-  
16 section (b) or (d) of such section, if—

17 (1) such school districts have entered into an  
18 agreement for such students to be so considered and  
19 for the equitable apportionment among all such  
20 school districts of any amount received by the North  
21 Chicago Community Unit School District 187 under  
22 such section; and

23 (2) any amount apportioned among all such  
24 school districts pursuant to paragraph (1) is used by

- 1 such school districts only for the direct provision of
- 2 educational services.
