A BILL

To permit health care providers to disclose certain protected health information to law enforcement officials.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ed Thomas Act of
- 5 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN PATIENT INFORMATION
- 7 TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.
- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—If—

1	(1) an individual is accompanied by a law en-
2	forcement official at the time such individual seeks
3	care from a covered entity:

- (2) such official provides to such entity a request, in writing, that the entity disclose to the official protected health information relating to such individual; and
- 8 (3) such written request is made during the pe-9 riod that begins when such individual seeks such 10 care and ends 24 hours after such individual is dis-11 charged from such care or otherwise stops receiving 12 such care,
- 13 section 164.512(f)(1) of title 45, Code of Federal Regula-
- 14 tions, shall apply to the disclosure of such information (in-
- 15 cluding the date of discharge) to the law enforcement
- 16 agency that employs such official by a covered entity in
- 17 the same manner that such section applies to the disclo-
- 18 sure of information by a covered entity in response to ad-
- 19 ministrative requests.

- 20 (b) Regulations.—Not later than 90 days after the
- 21 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health
- 22 and Human Services shall promulgate regulations to carry
- 23 out this section.
