## A BILL

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to require the owner or lawful possessor of a firearm to report its theft or loss.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Firearm Owners Re-
- 5 sponsibility Act".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT THAT OWNER OR LAWFUL POS-
2	SESSOR OF A FIREARM REPORT ITS THEFT
3	OR LOSS.
4	(a) Prohibition.—Section 922 of title 18, United
5	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6	lowing:
7	"(aa) It shall be unlawful for any person who lawfully
8	possesses or owns a firearm that has been shipped or
9	transported in, or has been possessed in or affecting, inter-
10	state or foreign commerce, to fail to report the theft or
11	loss of the firearm, within 72 hours after the person dis-
12	covers the theft or loss, to the Attorney General and to
13	the appropriate local authorities.".
14	(b) Penalties.—Section 924(a)(5) of such title is
15	amended by striking "(s) or (t)" and inserting "(t) or
16	(aa)"
