A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide authority to restrict competition to businesses within States that fund projects at military installations.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO RESTRICT COMPETITION TO 4 BUSINESSES WITHIN STATES THAT FUND 5 PROJECTS AT MILITARY INSTALLATIONS. Section 2304(c) of title 10, United States Code, is 6 amended— 7 (1) by striking "or" at the end of paragraph 8 9 (6);

1	(2) by striking the period at the end of para-
2	graph (7) and inserting "; or"; and
3	(3) by adding at the end the following new
4	paragraph:
5	"(8) the contract is for a military construction
6	project at a military installation in a State, the
7	State provided all funding for the project, and the
8	head of the agency—
9	"(A) determines that it is in the best inter-
10	est of the agency concerned to limit the sources
11	from which it solicits bids or proposals to pro-
12	spective contractors that have a physical pres-
13	ence in the State that provided the funding;
14	and
15	"(B) notifies the congressional defense
16	committees in writing of such determination not
17	less than 30 days before the award of the con-
18	tract.".
