A BILL

To withdraw Federal funds from States and political subdivisions of States that interfere with enforcement of Federal immigration law.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Putting an End to
- 5 Sanctuary Cities Act".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL

- 2 FUNDS.
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—No officer or employee of the Fed-
- 4 eral Government may provide Federal funds to any State,
- 5 or political subdivision of a State, that is determined by
- 6 the Secretary of Homeland Security to be interfering with
- 7 efforts to enforce Federal immigration laws.
- 8 (b) Termination of Funding Prohibition.—Sub-
- 9 section (a) shall cease to be effective with respect to a
- 10 State or political subdivision denied funds under such sub-
- 11 section when the Secretary of Homeland Security certifies
- 12 that the State or political subdivision has entered into an
- 13 agreement with the Secretary of Homeland Security to
- 14 cease such interference.
