A BILL

To prevent the participation of the Attorney General in any lawsuit that seeks to invalidate certain provisions of Arizona law relating to aliens unlawfully present in the United States without first satisfying certain conditions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sanctuary City Preven-

5 tion Act of 2010”.

1 **SEC. 2. IN GENERAL.**

2 The Attorney General may not expend funds made
3 available in any provision of law to participate in any law-
4 suit that seeks to invalidate those provisions of the Ari-
5 zona Revised Statutes amended by Arizona Senate Bill
6 1070, 49th Leg., 2nd Reg. Sess., Ch. 113 (Az. 2010) (as
7 amended by Arizona House Bill 2162, 49th Leg., 2nd
8 Reg. Sess., Ch. 211 (Az. 2010)) until the date that the
9 Attorney General submits to the Congress a report setting
10 forth a plan to enforce the immigration laws (as such term
11 is defined in section 101(a)(17) of the Immigration and
12 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(17))) in any State or
13 subdivision of a State that has in effect any law, policy,
14 or procedure in contravention of subsection (a) or (b) of
15 section 642 of the Illegal Immigrant Reform and Immi-
16 grant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1373).
