## A BILL

To restrict passports of certain sex offenders, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RESTRICTION OF PASSPORTS OF CERTAIN SEX
- 4 OFFENDERS.
- 5 (a) In General.—The Secretary of State may re-
- 6 voke, restrict, or limit a passport issued to an individual
- 7 who is a sex offender (as defined in section 111(1) of the
- 8 Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006 (42
- 9 U.S.C. 16911(4)) who is—

1	(1) included in the National Sex Offender Reg-
2	istry established pursuant to section 119 of such Act
3	(42 U.S.C. 16919); or

- 4 (2) required to register in a jurisdiction's sex 5 offender registry under title I of such Act and with 6 respect to whom information may be maintained in 7 the National Sex Offender Registry under such sec-8 tion 119.
- 9 (b) Report.—Not later than December 31, 2011, 10 and annually thereafter, the Secretary of State shall sub11 mit to Congress a report on the number of passports the
  12 Secretary has revoked, restricted, or limited in the pre13 ceding fiscal year under subsection (a) or any other provi14 sion of law.
