## A BILL

To limit the effect of legal releases in certain civil actions, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gulf Coast Oil Spill
- 5 Legal Liabilities and Claims Act of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON EFFECT OF LEGAL RELEASES IN
- 7 CERTAIN CIVIL ACTIONS.
- 8 No settlement, legal release, or other agreement shall
- 9 extinguish or limit liability in a civil action for significant
- 10 harm arising from a discharge into waters off the shore

1	of the United States of a substance that contaminates a
2	marine or coastal environment or endangers public health
3	if such settlement, legal release, or agreement is entered
4	into under coercion or duress or is entered into in ex-
5	change for any benefit other than a settlement of claims
6	pending.
7	SEC. 3. AMENDMENT TO CLASS ACTION FAIRNESS ACT.
8	Title 28, United States Code, is amended—
9	(1) in section 1711(2), by inserting ", but does
10	not include an action brought by a State or subdivi-
11	sion of a State on behalf of its citizens" before the
12	period;
13	(2) in section $1332(d)(1)(B)$ , by inserting ",
14	but does not include an action brought by a State
15	or subdivision of a State on behalf of its citizens'
16	before the semicolon; and
17	(3) in section 1332(d)(11)(B)(ii)—
18	(A) by striking "or" at the end of sub-
19	clause (III);
20	(B) by striking the period at the end of
21	subclause (IV) and inserting "; or"; and
22	(C) by adding at the end the following:
23	"(V) the claims are made by a State or subdivi-
24	sion of a State on behalf of its citizens.".
