Ms. MARKEY of Colorado introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To modify the boundary of Rocky Mountain National Park,
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rocky Mountain Na-
5 tional Park Boundary Modification Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK.**

7 (a) MODIFICATION OF BOUNDARY.—The boundary of
8 Rocky Mountain National Park is modified by—

9 (1) removing approximately 11.61 acres, known
10 as the “Winters property”; and

1 (2) adding two parcels of federally owned land,
2 consisting of approximately 33.88 acres.

3 (b) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The lands described in
4 subsection (a) are generally depicted on the map entitled
5 “Rocky Mountain National Park Proposed Boundary Re-
6 vision”, numbered 121/80,159B, and dated June 2010.

7 (c) MAP.—The map referred to in subsection (b) shall
8 be on file and available for inspection in the appropriate
9 offices of the National Park Service, Department of the
10 Interior.

11 (d) ADMINISTRATION OF LAND.—Lands added to the
12 park in subsection (a) shall be administered by the Sec-
13 retary of the Interior as part of the Rocky Mountain Na-
14 tional Park in accordance with applicable laws and regula-
15 tions.

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
