2	NOLOGY UNDER THE MEDICARE AND MED-
3	ICAID EHR INCENTIVE PAYMENT PROGRAMS.
4	(a) Medicare Program.—Section 1848(o)(4) of the
5	Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w-4(o)(4)) is amend-
6	ed by adding at the end the following: "For payment years
7	2011 and 2012, such term includes an electronic health
8	record that is not certified pursuant to such section
9	3001(c)(5) and that enables the demonstration of mean-
10	ingful EHR use for an EHR reporting period for the pay-
11	ment year involved.".
12	(b) Medicaid Program.—Section 1903(t)(3)(A) of
13	such Act (42 U.S.C. $1396b(t)(3)(A)$ ) is amended by add-
14	ing at the end the following: "For payment years 2011
15	and 2012, such term includes an electronic health record
16	that is not certified pursuant to such section 3001(c)(5)
17	and that enables a Medicaid provider to demonstrate
18	meaningful use for purposes of this subsection.".

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
