## A BILL

To deauthorize a portion of the project for navigation, Chi-  
cago Harbor, Illinois, under the jurisdiction of the Corps  
of Engineers.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DEAUTHORIZATION OF A PORTION OF THE**  
4                       **PROJECT FOR NAVIGATION, CHICAGO HAR-**  
5                       **BOR, ILLINOIS.**

6       The portion of the project for navigation, Chicago  
7 Harbor, Illinois, authorized by the Act of March 3, 1899  
8 (30 Stat. 1121) and the Act of March 2, 1919 (40 Stat.  
9 1275), that begins at the southwest corner of the Metro-

1 politan Sanitary District of Greater Chicago sluice gate  
2 that abuts the north wall of the Chicago River Lock and  
3 that continues north for approximately 290 feet, thence  
4 east approximately 1000 feet, thence south approximately  
5 290 feet, thence west approximately 1000 feet to the point  
6 of beginning, shall no longer be authorized after the date  
7 of enactment of this Act.
