- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DEAUTHORIZATION OF A PORTION OF THE
- 4 PROJECT FOR NAVIGATION, CHICAGO HAR-
- 5 BOR, ILLINOIS.
- 6 The portion of the project for navigation, Chicago
- 7 Harbor, Illinois, authorized by the Act of March 3, 1899
- 8 (30 Stat. 1121) and the Act of March 2, 1919 (40 Stat.
- 9 1275), that begins at the southwest corner of the Metro-

- 1 politan Sanitary District of Greater Chicago sluice gate
- 2 that abuts the north wall of the Chicago River Lock and
- 3 that continues north for approximately 290 feet, thence
- 4 east approximately 1000 feet, thence south approximately
- 5 290 feet, thence west approximately 1000 feet to the point
- 6 of beginning, shall no longer be authorized after the date
- 7 of enactment of this Act.
