A BILL

- To authorize the Secretary of the Interior, and in cooperation with the Koshare Indian Museum, to assist in the expansion of the Museum's storage facility in La Junta, Colorado, to house the collection of Bent's Old Fort National Historic Site and collections from other National Park Service units.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Bent's Old Fort Mu-
- 5 seum Collections Facility Act of 2010".

1 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

2	In this Act:
3	(1) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
4	the Secretary of the Interior.
5	(2) MUSEUM.—The term "Museum" means the
6	Koshare Indian Museum.
7	(3) NPS.—The term "NPS" means the Na-
8	tional Park Service.
9	SEC. 3. FINDINGS.
10	Congress finds that—
11	(1) the Museum, a long-established museum on
12	the Otero Junior College campus in La Junta, Colo-
13	rado, houses a world-class collection of Plains Indian
14	and other Native American material culture;
15	(2) the Museum is planning an expansion of its
16	collections' storage facility;
17	(3) the Museum and Otero Junior College have
18	developed architectural plans for the new facility;
19	(4) the expanded collections storage facility
20	could house the collections of Bent's Old Fort, Sand
21	Creek Massacre, and possibly collections from other
22	National Park System units; and
23	(5) NPS staff assigned to the storage facility
24	could manage the NPS collections to NPS standards
25	and assist in the curation of the Museum's collec-
26	tions.

1 SEC. 4. AGREEMENT.

2 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary may enter into
3 a cooperative agreement with the Museum to—

4 (1) assist in the construction and furnishing of
5 an addition to the museum for use as a curatorial
6 center to house the museum collections from Bent's
7 Old Fort, Sand Creek Massacre, and other units of
8 the National Park System;

9 (2) provide no more than \$6,000,000 for the
10 construction and furnishing of the addition to the
11 Museum subject to available appropriations; and

(3) house those portions of the collections of
Bent's Old Fort, Sand Creek Massacre, and Washita
Battlefield National Historic Sites, and possibly collections from other units of the National Park System, that the Director of the NPS determines appropriate for the facility.

(b) FUNDING.—Federal funding provided under subsection (a) shall be matched on a 1:1 Federal to non-Federal basis, and the non-Federal contribution may be in the
form of in-kind contributions of goods or services fairly
valued.

(c) OTHER CONDITIONS.—The curatorial addition
authorized by this Act shall remain part of the Museum
and the Museum shall be responsible for maintenance and

operational costs associated with the Museum including
 the curatorial addition.

3 SEC. 5. USE OF STAFF.

4 The Secretary may assign NPS staff to—

5 (1) provide curatorial services for the NPS mu-6 seum objects housed at the Museum; and

7 (2) to assist with the curation of other objects8 housed at the Museum.
