A BILL

To require the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to establish and maintain a Web site to track the expenditure of Government funds.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR WEB SITE TO TRACK EX-
- 4 PENDITURE OF GOVERNMENT FUNDS.
- 5 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR WEB SITE.—The Director of
- 6 the Office of Management and Budget shall establish and
- 7 maintain a publicly available Web site for the purpose of
- 8 tracking all expenditures of funds appropriated or other-
- 9 wise available to the Federal Government.

- 1 (b) Exception for Small Expenditures.—The
- 2 Web site established under subsection (a) shall not track
- 3 any expenditure in an amount of \$500 or less.
- 4 (c) Additional Requirements.—In carrying out
- 5 subsection (a), the Director shall—
- 6 (1) set forth in detail the expenditures of funds;
- 7 and
- 8 (2) ensure that classified expenditures are ap-
- 9 propriately protected.
- 10 (d) DEADLINE.—The Web site required by subsection
- 11 (a) shall be fully implemented not later than 120 days
- 12 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
