Ms. LORETTA SANCHEZ of California (for herself and Mr. HALL of Texas) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend title 44, United States Code, to require each agency to include contact information for the agency in its collection of information.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Paperwork Assistance
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION REQUIREMENT.**

7 Section 3506(c)(1)(B)(iii) of title 44, United States
8 Code, is amended—

1 (1) in subclause (IV) by striking “and” at the
2 end; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(VI) contact information for the
5 agency, including a website and a tele-
6 phone number, by which a person may
7 obtain a specific contact person re-
8 sponsible for answering questions
9 about the information collection and
10 other information to assist in respond-
11 ing to the information collection;
12 and”.

13 **SEC. 3. REPORT BY THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND**
14 **BUDGET.**

15 The Director of the Office of Management and Budg-
16 et shall include in the report required by section
17 3514(a)(1)(B) of title 44, United States Code, covering
18 fiscal year 2012 the following:

19 (1) The status of implementation by agencies of
20 the requirement in section 3506(c)(1)(B)(iii)(VI) of
21 such title 44, as added by section 2 of this Act.

22 (2) A description of how each agency has re-
23 sponded to complaints made to the agency related to
24 the agency’s compliance with such requirement.

1 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendment made by section 2 shall apply to new
3 or revised collections of information approved by the Di-
4 rector of the Office of Management and Budget beginning
5 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act.
