4	In the case of a State that has a provider tax that
5	does not does not apply to continuing care retirement com-
6	munities or life care communities (as such terms are used
7	for purposes of section 1917(g) of the Social Security Act
8	(42 U.S.C. 1396p(g)) that have no beds that are certified
9	to provide medical assistance (as such term is defined
10	under section 1905(a) of such Act) under title XIX of the
11	Social Security Act or that do not provide services for
12	which payment may be made under title XIX of the Social

14	shall approve a waiver under section 433.68(e)(2)(iii) of
