To amend title 10, United States Code, to ensure the timeliness of information used in considering a member of the Armed Forces for an administrative separation, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3 SECTION 1. USE OF CURRENT INFORMATION IN CONSID-4ERING A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES

5 FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SEPARATION.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 59 of title 10, United
7 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol8 lowing new section:

3 "(a) TIMELINESS OF INFORMATION CONSIDERED.—
4 If a member of the armed forces is being considered under
5 applicable regulations for administrative separation, inci6 dents involving the member and information regarding the
7 actions of the member occurring more than 10 years be8 fore the date of the proceedings may not be taken into
9 consideration.

10 "(b) EXCEPTIONS.—Subsection (a) does not apply 11 if—

12 "(1) the member consents to the consideration13 of the earlier information; or

14 "(2) the information was concealed by the
15 member or another person acting on behalf of the
16 member.".

17 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections18 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by at the19 end the following new item:

"1179. Administrative separation: use of current information regarding member.".
