1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Longfellow House5 Washington's Headquarters National Historic Site Des6 ignation Act".

7 SEC. 2. REDESIGNATION.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Longfellow National Historic
9 Site in Cambridge, Massachusetts, shall be known and re10 designated as the "Longfellow House-Washington's Head11 quarters National Historic Site".

(b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
 States to the Longfellow National Historic Site shall be
 deemed to be a reference to the "Longfellow House-Wash ington's Headquarters National Historic Site".
